

## FUN SAILING PROGRAM – How To

An important SBC membership benefit is the option for most members to reserve and sail one of the club's Cape Cod Mercuries used for the SBC Jr. Sailing program. The Fun Sailing program, also referred to as the Adult Sailing Program, is available to members after fulfilling requirements outlined in the Fun Sailing Overview document also contained in the Fun (Adult) Sailing page (in the Members Area) of the SBC website. Adult SBC members will be able to "check-out" the club owned Mercuries when they are not being used by Junior Sailing.

First, read and understand the program information contained in the document titled *Fun Sailing Overview* contained on the Fun (Adult) Sailing website page. This document contains the rules/regs of the program and required Liability form.

There will be a \$50 per season fee for the program. You will be billed by the treasurer after signing up for the first time.

### Step 1:

Familiarize yourself with the rules/regs of the program. Print out a copy and sign the Liability Waiver document. Bring the signed document and place in the designated folder in the Clubhouse. (located near the telephone). There will be extra copies there in case you don't have a printer or forget.

### Step 2:

Visit [Calendly.com/satuitboatclub](https://calendly.com/satuitboatclub) by selecting *Schedule a Boat* on the Fun (Adult) Sailing website page. Select a boat (Mercury 1, 2, 3, 4) The boats have number stickers on the decks. Select a date/time. (available times will be listed for each boat. each time slot will be 2 hours)

### Step 3:

Rig the boat - go sailing - have fun. Equipment is in the shed by the kayak rack.

### Step 4:

Return the boat in good condition, put everything away where you found it (in the shed) and wipe the boats down with disinfecting wipes.

Please remember that the boats are used every weekday morning for Junior Sailing at 8:30am. It is imperative that the equipment be put away exactly where it was and in good order to ensure a good morning for the junior sailors.
